CUSTOMS OIL AND GAS FTZ COMMAND GENERATES 22 BILLION **10 MONTHS**

The PH Oil and Gas FTZ Command of the ■ Nigeria Customs Service announced a revenue collection exceeding 22 billion naira over the past 10 months.

Customs Area Controller, Comptroller Abubakar Umar, shared this achievement on 21 November 2023 at the Nigeria Customs Service PH Oil and Gas FTZ Command, Marble House, Oil and Gas Free Zone Authority Building, Onne, Rivers State.

Comptroller Umar revealed that as of 20 November 2023, the command's revenue stands at \22,413,619,459.00, compared to N21,219,846,074.00 collected between 1 January 2022 and 31 December 2022.

"He highlighted a collection increase of over 1 billion naira compared to the previous year.

The CAC expressed optimism about surpassing the annual target before the end of 2023. "By the Grace of God, before December 31, 2023, we will surpass our annual target".
